Completion rules and prerequisites allow you to create a defined work flow within a course or among different courses.

Affidavits

Click a product name or asset name within a product to open it and then click the Completion Rules link under the properties menu. Completion rules can be set up for any product by site managers, publishers and desktop managers.

Step 2: Select from the Available Conditions

Select one of the available conditions and then click save. You can find a full description the available conditions below. Once the completion rule is defined, you can create prerequisites.

Available Completion Rule Conditions

Different completion rules will be available depending upon the setup and type of the item.

Choose to have the asset or product considered complete the first time a participant opens it, or after a participant has spent the specified amount of time or longer with the item page open. Available for all products and asset types, except for evaluations.

This default setting has no completion rule. Available for all products and asset types.

Passing Select Items

Never Complete

Select the assets that need to be completed in order for the product to be considered complete. Note that the asset also needs to have a completion rule defined in order for it available for selection. Available for any products that have assets with completion rules defined.

Passing This Item

Select this condition to accept the asset as complete when a passing grade has been assigned. Note that some assets, (particularly SCORM files) may not be designed to announce completion. Available only for automatically graded assets, i.e. modules, evaluations, and SCORM assets.

Pass Rate

Select "passing this item with a pass rate of" requires you to enter a percentage that the participant must achieve for this item to be considered complete. Available for evaluation assets.

Affidavit Accepted

Select "when the affidavit is accepted " and this asset will be complete once the affidavit is accepted. Available for reference, module, and assignment assets.

Completion Rules VS Prerequisites

Completion Rules

Completion rules are optional conditions that must be satisfied by a participant before a product or asset is considered completed. Completion rules are not necessary for a participant to receive a grade or a certification.

When to use:

Setting up completion rules must be done if you wish to set up prerequisites or enable product expiry email alerts.

Prerequisites

A prerequisite is an item that must be completed before another item can be accessed. Setting up prerequisites is optional and you can add new ones or delete existing ones at any time.

Informetica is set up so only one prerequisite can be set up for the same product or asset, however each prerequisite can cover several products and assets. Items with prerequisites are indicated with a flag in several places within Informetica, but the flag is not visible to participants.

When to use:

Completion rules must be set up prior to creating prerequisites. Use prerequisites to restrict access to specific products or assets until all prerequisites are met. Prerequisites can be defined for one product or among different products.

Enter the number of items that must be completed before this product or asset can be accessed. Select as many of the items from the list as necessary and then click save. If you select more items than the number you entered, the system will accept any of the items once that number has been reached. For example, you can require any one of 1 of 3 assets be completed as a prerequisite.
